Financial update

Following sermon last week

Our treasurer Roger's regular report to the PCC has shown steady progress this year so far. We have kept up with our 'Share' payments— **about £3000 each month** — thank you for your generous giving as well as work on the Parish Magazine and fundraising. Unfortunately, over the last couple of months we've had a large electricity bill - £1200 - and also our annual insurance bill - £1800 - which have dented our regular finances somewhat. We are currently projected a shortfall of £4000 for 2018 unless we carry some costs over to next year or increase our revenue. There is also a long term loan of £4000 from a member of the church that we would like to pay back at some point.

Renovating and Reimagining - updates

Alongside our regular income and expenditure we also have a number of projects that are at various stages of progress to help renovate, repair or restore part of the church building. This finance is ring-fenced for projects and the fabric of the church, to ensure it is used for what it was given for. Here are our current projects and their status:

Faculty (Permission) granted:

Repair of Windows - contractor instructed - cost £10,000 covered by successful applications for grants.

<u>Chancel frontal replacement</u> – craftsman instructed – cost up to £12,000 of which £5500 has been raised so far.

Faculty advised and pending:

<u>Safe fixed Bell tower ladder</u> – cost £6000 already in a special tower fund.

<u>Tomb repairs in church and churchyard</u> – contractor ready to carry out work early next year – total cost £10,000 to raise, hopefully the majority can be raised from grants.

Obtaining quotes prior to applying for permission and Lion Hall Trust grant:

New sound system - estimated cost £12,000

Projector and drop down screen — estimated cost £10,000

Additional works:

<u>Updated electrical wiring and energy efficient lighting system</u> – cost to be established and funds to be raised.
