## APCM

We were finally able to hold our APCM last Sunday (postponed from 29 March) with fifteen members present. Mat Riddell has stood down as Warden after six years and been replaced by Ann Manning. Jayne Catley and Andy Dawson have completed their three-year terms of office and (as Heather Argent had resigned from the PCC earlier this year) the three vacancies were filled by Karen Hesketh, David Mould and Kat Riddell. Andy, who is a qualified electrician, remains our Health and Safety Officer.

Roger encouraged us by saying that, despite the Parish Share for 2020 having been substantially increased and our income having been decreased due to Covid-19 restrictions which have affected our fundraising, our payments are currently thankfully up to date. We have had donations in excess of £500 from people elsewhere in the UK watching Stephen's livestream services. He added that he'd been investigating ways of receiving contactless donations for some time now, and was in the process of obtaining a SumUp system for use primarily at non-standard church services and fundraising events. We would also have it available at church services just in case, and it will allow fundraising to also be undertaken electronically in due course.

At the meeting we adopted a resolution "to allow the option of holding the APCM in an alternative format, such as online, in future years if a need is identified and agreed by the PCC beforehand". Hopefully we **will** be able to hold our APCM in the usual format again next year though! **Riette**

## Harvest Festival

As we celebrate our **Harvest Festival** this weekend we are mindful that there is a growing need for basic everyday items to help those who are struggling locally. Bishop Tom Wright, in his book 'God and the Pandemic' reminds us that, as Christians, we are called to be people of prayer and action at the places where people are struggling and in pain. At our Harvest collection we can only really collect sealed items for the foodbank this year, I hope you can find imaginative ways of sharing other produce that you have. We will collect your boxes, packets, tins and jars at the services in **Church on 4th October**, or you can take them straight to Lisa who coordinates the village Foodbank, she has set up a box for donations outside her house 39 Cecil Place.
