Welcome to the St Mary's Church family We are a diverse Church community meeting in and for our village

#### Would you like to be confirmed?

The Baptism of a child is a wonderful chance to welcome a whole family into the Church, and a reminder of our own baptismal vows. The Church of England also has a service for those that were baptised as young children to step up and profess their faith for themselves – this is what happens at a **Service of Confirmation**, where the Bishop then 'confirms' this faith with the laying on of hands. In the past this service was seen as the gateway to receiving Holy Communion, but, more recently, churches have recognised that not everyone was given the chance to get confirmed, and so a more open Communion table is practised.

This now means that people can choose to be confirmed at all ages from 7 to 97, after some appropriate preparation. I have heard that early next year there is a service of Confirmation being led by Bishop Karen, in the Deanery, at St Luke's Parkstone - on 29th January at 5pm. If anyone is interested in being confirmed then do please speak to me, or chat to Jayne about her experience of being confirmed as an adult. **Stephen** 

## **East Dorset Branch Ringing Practice**

As with our bells if one of the parts is not working the bells will not ring properly - referring to the clapper, wheel and headstock. So as with our bodies the bells depend on all parts working together as one. Stephen stayed on to enjoy a delicious tea made by all the Lytchett Matravers ringers and organised by Ann **Manning** and **Helen Gorman.** Helen then featured during the meeting as she was welcomed as a new full member of the Branch. Helen comes all the way from Bournemouth for practices and early on a Sunday morning to ring for our services.
