

Thursday Home Group



St Mary's supports a local foodbank based at Purbeck Gateway Church, Wareham.

Deliveries are made approximately once a month by a small team of volunteers.

They are grateful for our donations of essential items with a long shelf life. Tinned fruit, vegetables, meat and fish are particularly welcome as are tea bags, coffee, milk, cereals and biscuits. Donations of toiletries, toilet rolls, washing up liquid, cleaning materials and laundry liquid are also accepted. Any donations can be left in the box in church or at Mursells Estate Agency.


If you are able to offer some time to help with deliveries, please do speak with Stephen or Karen.
